

MICHAEL MARK MARKLEY WAS BORN ON DECEMBER 8, 1946 IN ROGERS, ARKANSAS. HE GREW UP IN TEXAS WHERE HIS FATHER WAS STATIONED AT VARIOUS AIR FORCE BASES. HE GRADUATED IN 1964 FROM POLYTECHNIC HIGH SCHOOL IN FORT WORTH. MICHAEL EARNED AN UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE (1968) AND A LAW DEGREE (1972) FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS AT AUSTIN. HE WAS A MEMBER OF THE STATE BAR OF TEXAS FOR OVER FIFTY YEARS.

MICHAEL MARRIED HIS WIFE, MERIL, ON DECEMBER 1, 1990. A FEW WEEKS LATER THEY MOVED TO PARIS, FRANCE WHERE THEY LIVED FOR TWO YEARS. AFTER RETURNING TO THE U.S., THEY BOUGHT A HOME IN THE WOODLANDS, TX AND HAVE LIVED HERE EVER SINCE.

IN ADDITION TO MERIL, MICHAEL IS SURVIVED BY HIS SISTER, MARY MARKLEY, AS WELL AS BY HER SONS CHRISTOPHER WRIGHT GARDNER AND JAKE WRIGHT, AND THEIR FAMILIES. MICHAEL ALSO LEAVES BEHIND DEAR FRIENDS IN TEXAS AND BEYOND WHO ENRICHED HIS LIFE BEYOND MEASURE.
